154. **Pinot Grigio: Riff ~Terra Alpina~ IGT Delle Venezia, Italy 2009** \$12 / 46
~Medium-bodied, dry. Lemon aromas with a pear & apple palate. Clean, crisp tropical finish.
145. **Chardonnay: Boschendal ~1685 ~ South Africa 2009** \$11 / 42
~Medium-bodied, dry. Lightly oaked with notes of butter, lime, and grapefruit.
182. **Sauvignon Blanc: Sandy Cove ~ Marlborough, New Zealand 2010** \$11 / 42
~Medium-bodied, dry. Lemon, gooseberry, green melon, light grass, bright acids.
106. **Soave: Alpha Zeta ~ Verona-Veneto, Italy 2009** \$9 / 34
Medium-bodied, dry. Our favorite Soave returns by the glass. Made from 100% Garganega, New Zealander Matt Thomson reinterprets this grape by keeping it fresh, zingy, lemony and clean.

314. **Brut Prosecco: Bisol ~Desiderio Jeio~ Veneto, Italy NV** \$11 / 42
~Medium-bodied, dry. Fruity with hints currant on a complex background of apples & pears.

181. **Bandol: Domaine Tempier ~ Provence, France 2008** \$12 / 46
~Medium-bodied, dry. A great opportunity to try one of the best French Rose' perfectly aged. Spice, muted red berry, and nice tannins.

252. **Montepulciano D'Abruzzo: il Faggio ~ Abruzzo, Italy 2009** \$9 / 34
~Full medium-bodied, fruity. Spicy black fruit, a touch of oak, and coffee on the dry finish.
802. **Cabernet Sauvignon: Joel Gott ~ California 2009** \$12 / 46
~Medium-bodied, dry. Fruit forward and easy-drinking with ample tannin, oak and acidity.
820. **Pinot Noir: Sean Minor ~Four Bears~ Central Coast, CA 2010** \$12 / 46
~Medium-bodied, dry. Bright strawberry fruit on the nose followed by sweet, summer red berries on the palate. A touch of spice on an easy finish.
204. **Merlot: Michael Sullberg ~Sonoma County, California 2010** \$9 / 34
~Medium-bodied, fruity. Silky dark blackberries with notes of cocoa, spice, and vanilla.
943. **Zinfandel: Van Ruiten ~Old Vines~ Lodi, CA 2008** \$11 / 42
~ Full-bodied, dry. A refined Zin made from 50 year-old vines and aged in 100% American oak (50% new) for 8 months. Black-fruit jam on the nose followed by notes of blackberry, coffee, cedar and licorice. The long finish has plenty of drying tannins and lifted acids.
227. **Côtes du Rhône ~ Domaine Pesquier - Sablet-Rhône, France 2009** \$10 / 38
*~Medium-bodied, dry. A serious Cotes du Rhone with a nose & palate of dark red fruit, cherry and licorice root, and a finish of fine tannins. Only 700 cases are made of this blend of Grenache 70%, Mourvedre 20%, and 10% Carignan & Cinsault, all grown on 5 acres. **Organic***
